 We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Standalone Unaudited Financial Results of MAHINDRA LIFESPACE DEVELOPERS LIMITED ("the Company"), for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016.

This Statement which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. 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INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM FINANCIAL RESULTS

1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Consolidated Unaudited Financial Results of MAHINDRA LIFESPACE DEVELOPERS LIMITED ("the Parent") and its subsidiaries (the Parent and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group"), and its share of the profit of its joint ventures for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Parent pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016.

This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Parent's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.

We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of Parent's personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and, accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

4. Based on our review conducted as stated above and based on the consideration of the review reports of other auditors referred to in Paragraph 5 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standards ("Ind AS") and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.



5. We did not review the interim financial information of three subsidiaries included in the consolidated unaudited financial results, whose interim financial information total revenues of Rs. 34 lakhs and Rs. 2,554 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 respectively, total loss after tax of Rs. 421 lakhs and Rs. 611 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 respectively and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 421 lakhs and Rs. 611 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 respectively, as considered in the Statement. The Statement also includes the Group's share of profit after tax of Rs. 1,185 lakhs and Rs. 4,056 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 and total comprehensive income of Rs. 1,185 lakhs and Rs. 4,056 lakhs for the guarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 respectively, as considered in the Statement, in respect of three joint ventures, whose interim financial information have not been reviewed by us. These interim financial information have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our report on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries and joint ventures, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors.

Our report on the Statement is not modified in respect of these matters.

6. The consolidated unaudited financial results includes the interim financial information of nine subsidiaries which have not been reviewed by their auditors, whose interim financial information reflect revenue of Rs. 33 lakhs and Rs. 84 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 respectively and total profit after tax of Rs. 15 lakhs and Rs. 38 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 respectively and total comprehensive income of Rs. 15 lakhs and Rs. 38 lakhs for the guarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 respectively, as considered in the Statement. The Statement also includes the Group's share of loss after tax of Rs. 34 lakhs and Rs. 47 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 respectively and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 34 lakhs and Rs. 47 lakhs for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 respectively, as considered in the Statement, in respect of two joint ventures, based on their interim financial information which have not been reviewed by their auditors. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial information are not material to the Group.



Our report on the Statement is not modified in respect of our reliance on the interim financial information certified by the Management.
